

Push-button programming

- 1. Press and hold the left button of your original remote control
- 2. Press briefly the right button, then release both buttons
- 3. The LEDs will emit a few blinks that will give the code of your remote control
- 4. The red LED corresponds to the OFF position (programming with dip switches)
- 5. The green LED corresponds to the ON position (programming with dip switches)


Red LED off/green LED ON



Red LED= "-"
Green LED="+"
Green and red LED= "0"



Push-button programming:



Push button coding:

- 1. Press and hold the left button of your original remote control
- 2. Press briefly the right button, then release both buttons
- 3. The LEDs will emit a few blinks that will give the code of your remote control
- 4. Press and hold one of the buttons. The two LEDs blink briefly
- 5. Immediately, program the new remote control by pressing according to the coding on the above figures on the left or right button of your remote control
- 6. The LEDs blink briefly

Dip switch coding:

- 1. Place your remote controls in ON or OFF positions according to the above codes
- 2. Test your new remote control
